

Mystery Matrix

Below is part of a multiplication square (much like the one we do on a Monday morning).

The numbers 2—12 were used to generate it, with one number used twice. Some of the answers are entered to give you clues as to what times table each row or column might be from.

Your job is to try and work out and complete all the missing squares so that the grid is complete and correct.

You may need to try a few different combinations before you find the right one. Don't give up!

The maths skills needed in terms of the calculations is very straightforward (just your 2-12 times tables) the real skill here is thinking logically to find the correct solution.
