This week we have been learning the digraphs "oi" (in boil) and "ear" (in hear), reading words and captions containing the sounds.

Our tricky word focus has been "they".

We have been continuing our learning about our topic, **Up and Away**.

We have designed and made 2 differently sized **gyrocopters** to test which one will land safely and gently, and 2 **parachutes** made from **different materials** to test which material helps the parachute to fly for the longest time!

We have also watched our class teddies parachute off a tall tower and used the vocabulary we have learnt through our observations of things flying and floating to write down what happened as he fell.

Our maths focus has been on **counting back** from a number to another number e.g. from 14-10.

What will happen when Teddy jumps off the tower?

The parachute will blow up and trap all the air inside and he will float down
