Punctuality

We would like to ask for your support in helping your children get to school on time. In recent weeks the number of children arriving to school late has increased, especially in KS1. The soft start gives the children time to settle in to class at any time from 8.50am onwards with all children expected to be in class by 9.00am ready to start the school day. Research shows that it is vitally important to children's education that they are in school and on time. It can affect a child's self esteem if they arrive late on a regular basis, even by just a few minutes, as they can feel others are looking at them. Please do all you can to support them in getting to school on time. We have a breakfast club which can be useful to make sure the children are here, settled and have eaten something before class. If, for any reason, you are struggling with mornings, please speak to us and we may be able to help.
