Over this half-term complete at least two of these homework activities. The two pieces must be from different subjects

Think carefully about which ones you want to do, and remember to create a really quality piece of work to share with the rest of the class!

	<p>Create a book cover for a collection of myths and legends using folded A4 paper.</p> <p>Make the front cover and the blurb on the back cover with extra detail like barcode, newspaper review comments e.g. I couldn't put this book down— The Times etc.</p>	<p>Write a jingle to sell an imaginary Greek product. Choose an imaginary product e.g Shampoo for snake hair like Medusa, special potion to make you fly, chariot oil to go super-fast. Then create a song to sell it.</p> <p>Make sure the song is catchy and sticks in your head e.g 'Washing machines live longer with Calgon' to be performed to the class.</p>	<p>Compose an Awesome Ancient Greek Rap.</p> <p>Choose either your Greek God or a well-known Greek God and write a rap about them.</p> <p>Be ready to perform your rap to the class. You could create a beat for the class to do while you read in order to keep the rhythm.</p>
	<p>Using Word or Publisher design the front of a Greek Newspaper. 	<p>Write a newspaper article</p> <p>Create an exciting article for the front page of the Ancient Greek Times involving your Greek God. Use the A4 newspaper article writing frame sheet. Include: A catchy Headline, 5Ws in the sub heading and the article in two columns. Extension: Include quotes (witnesses/ peoples speech).</p>	<p>Write an advertisement for an imaginary Ancient Greek product</p> <p>Create an imaginary <u>Ancient Greek product</u>. E.g. Shampoo for snake hair like Medusa, special potion to make you fly, chariot oil to go super-fast, magic horse, medal. Be as creative as possible and as imaginative. Include snappy slogan, picture, price, a persuasive description of the item.</p>	<p>Write a blurb for an Ancient Greek story.</p> <p>Think of an idea for a story involving a Greek God. You do not need to write the story, just write an exciting blurb for the back of a book cover for your story. Look at blurbs on the back of books you read to get ideas for setting out your own blurb.</p>
