	<p>We have been learning about chocolate! Design and create your own brand of tasty Fair-Trade Chocolate! You may want to draw a detailed sketch with labels or even create a 3D model!</p> <p>You may want to think about what attracts you to your favourite chocolate bars. Be prepared to present your chocolate bar to the class!</p>	<p>We have been reading Varjak Paw! Create a model of the legend that is Jalal! Remember that Jalal Paw is a great warrior and his stories have gone down in history! He must be an incredible specimen of a cat!</p> <p>You may want to think about a detailed sketch OR even a 3D model! Challenge yourself to use different materials!</p>	<p>Varjak Paw is set in Mesopotamia and the Big City! Create a detailed map for one of these settings.</p> <p>You may want to think about making your map interactive, 3D or even from the point of view of a cat!</p>
	<p>The setting of Varjak Paw is Ancient Mesopotamia. Create a fun PowerPoint presentation that gives children a feeling of what Mesopotamia was like for Jalal!</p> <p>You may want to think about how a presentation must be informative and entertaining. Your audience must have fun whilst learning!</p>	<p>We have watched and read Charlie and the Chocolate Factory! Create your own Minecraft chocolate factory world.</p> <p>You may want to think about new and unusual ways you can mix or create chocolate in your factory, just like Wonka! You will then present it to the class!</p>	<p>We have been learning about how chocolate is made. Create an animation, comic book, video or audio to describe how chocolate is made.</p> <p>You may want to think about where cocoa comes from and the steps needed to make it into a chocolate bar.</p>
	<p>We have been reading Varjak Paw, whose main characters are cats! Write a poem, song or rap about life as a cat.</p> <p>You may want to record your piece or put it to music!</p>	<p>We have been learning about Fair trade! Create a diary from the point of view of a non-Fair-Trade farmer.</p> <p>You may want to think about researching the conditions and jobs of these farmers. Try to make it believable so you can perform it!</p>	<p>In science we are learning about the properties of solids, liquids and gases. Research and write an information text or information poster about reversible and irreversible changes in water.</p> <p>You may want to experiment with different materials and present your science in a fun engaging way!</p>
