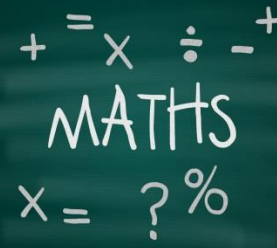
Create your own beach using a box.
