**Over this term complete at least two of these homework activities. The two pieces must be from different subjects.**

Think carefully about which ones you want to do, and remember to create a really quality piece of work to share with the rest of the class!

 <p>Any piece of artwork that the children produce for home learning needs to have a piece of writing to go with it that explains what they did or what they learnt.</p>	<p><b>We have been learning about Stone Age Cave paintings. Create a Stone Age Painting using Stone Age paint. You will need charcoal, vegetable oil and a rock to grind.</b> You may want to try painting using sticks or feathers. Try drawing some stick figures, animals or symbols.</p>	<p><b>Design and make your own Stone Age necklace.</b></p> <p>You may want to use materials such as they used in the Stone Age- rocks, sticks, leaves shells.</p>	<p><b>Stone Age houses were made from the materials that people could find around them. Create your own model Stone Age houses using different materials you find outside.</b> You may want to collect twigs to make the structure and use leaves, moss or even some grass for the roof.</p>
 <p><b>Create a fun PowerPoint presentation that gives children lots of information about Stone Age homes or any other aspect you would like to learn more about/teach others.</b> You may want to think about how a presentation must be informative and entertaining. Your audience must have fun whilst learning!</p>	<p><b>This term we will be finding out all about rocks in science.</b> Do your own research into rocks and create a poster or information booklet ready to share with the class. Maybe you could even find some examples of different rocks to show the class?</p>	<p><b>Later this term we will be finding out all about teeth in science. Create an informative poster about teeth.</b> You may want to describe the different types of teeth, the function of each type and how to take care of them.</p>	
 <p><b>Write an alternative version to Lost and Found</b> You might like to think about a different animal that has been found, the setting, where they go and where they end up.</p>	<p><b>Create an information book about life in the Stone Age.</b> You might like to use headings like ‘Stone Age Food’, ‘Stone Age Tools and Weapons’, ‘Stone Age Houses’ and you need to include pictures, captions and facts.</p>	<p><b>Write a story set in the Stone Age.</b> Think about what your characters will do each day, what will happen? Will something go wrong? How will it be solved?</p>
