

## In Year 6 we are learning about **'ALL THE WORLD'S A STAGE'!**

The emphasis this term is on creating a piece of home learning that is stunning and putting thought into how you will share it with the class effectively !

	<p><b>CREATE YOUR OWN TUDOR THEATRE!</b> Using household materials create a Tudor Theatre. Think about the resources and material that would have been available. Where would your theatre be located and why? What would you name it and why? Attach an annotated design and short description.</p>	<p><b>BE A TAILOR!</b> Create a costume or prop that would symbolise a Shakespearean character. Attach an annotated design and a short description.</p>	<p><b>BE AN ILLUSTRATOR</b> Create a comic strip, with a story to go alongside art inspired by Japanese artist, Hokusai.</p>
	<p><b>BE A QUIZ MASTER!</b> Choose a famous Shakespearean play. Prepare a presentation to educate the class, with a quiz to assess how much they were listening. Make sure you know the answers and you may even be asked questions yourself!</p>	<p><b>BE A RETELLER!</b> Write an alternative version of a 'classic' Shakespearean text tale. Don't be afraid to shock, frighten and entertain your audience! Ideally the story will be detailed and have a definite beginning, middle and end! You could do this in the form of a comic strip.</p>	<p><b>INFORM or INSTRUCT!</b> Create a creative fact file about an island around the world.</p> <p>OR</p> <p>Create a set of instructions for how to create a Shakespearean comedy.</p>
	<p><b>BE A MOVIE DIRECTOR!</b> Design and create a trailer for a modern version of a Shakespeare play of your choice.</p>	<p><b>Be AN ENGLISH TEACHER!</b> Create a power point or prezi that explores the question: Is Shakespeare still relevant? Can you express both sides of the argument and persuade your audience to agree with your personal view?</p>	<p><b>BE AN ANIMATOR!</b> Create an animation exploring the classification system. The animation should inform your audience all about how it works, giving examples.</p>
