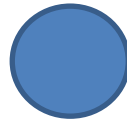

And one for the little boy

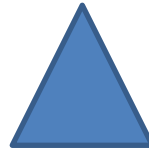

If you were unable to come to the Forum, but have suggestions, please do speak to Amanda.

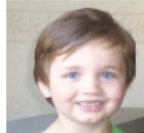
