We have also been learning a new song to help us learn the **days of the week**. Ask me to show you the actions.

This week we have been learning the trigraphs **"ure"** (in sure), **"air"** (in fair), and the digraph **"er"** (in flower), reading words and captions containing the sounds. Our tricky word focus has been **"her"**.

We have written **Easter** cards, made Easter nests and decorated boiled eggs to give as gifts in our homemade Easter baskets.

The Easter Bunny paid us a visit and the children went on an **Easter Egg hunt** in the playground, **counting the eggs** to find the winning class!

In Maths we learnt how to make a **tally** to find out which Easter egg was our favourite. Then we represented our results in a **bar chart**, finding out which egg was the most **popular**. We were also very lucky to be visited by the **Fire Brigade** on Thursday and the children loved finding out about their exciting job! Our maths focus has been on **ordering numbers to 20**.
