ParentPay


We are pleased to announce that we will shortly be accepting payments online for items such as school meals, extra-curricular activities, breakfast club, after school clubs, trips & uniform. Using a secure website called ParentPay you will be able to pay online using your credit or debit card. We will continue to take cash payments up until the end of term. As of Tuesday 8th January 2019, the school will be completely cashless. (Parents can make cash payments at PayPoint stores).

What does ParentPay do

- enables you to pay for school meals, extra-curricular activities, such as breakfast club and after school clubs, trips and uniform
- offers a highly secure payment site
- gives you a history of all the payments you have made
- allows you to create a single account login across all your children that attend a ParentPay school
- shows you all items available for payment relevant to each of your children
- emails a receipt of your payment to the email address you register
- offers you the ability to set automated email/SMS payment reminders How does ParentPay help you?
- gives you the freedom to make payments to school whenever and wherever you like
- stops you having to write cheques or search for cash to send to school
- gives you peace of mind that your payment has been made safely and securely
- helps with budgeting; payments are immediate, there is no waiting for cheques to clear
- payments for many of the larger trips can be made by instalments up to the due date
 - you will never need miss a payment, or have insufficient credit, with automated email/SMS alerts
- ParentPay is quick and easy to use.
