The address is as follows: Hoop Lane, Golders Green, London NW11 7NL.






Please don't forget to activate your ParentPay ParentPay accounts. ParentPay is quick and easy to use and gives you the freedom to make payments to school

The Girls narrowly lost both games, and were very unlucky. But played extremely well and we are very proud of them.




The Boys drew both games and remain the top of the league. Well done to both teams!

We also had a Guess the Malteasers in the jar competition. We had many guesses but there could only be


one winner. With a the closest guess to the winning answer of 176 malteasers
