#### **School Lunches**

Please remember if you are changing from packed lunch to school dinner or visa versa the school office must be informed and a meal change form must be completed. The office will give parents a copy of the meal change form as part of our procedures. If you do decide to change meal types and fail to notify the office or fail to complete a meal change form, you will be expected and be responsible to pay for any amount that accumulates.

Changes can only happen half termly, therefore we will be accepting meal change forms up until Friday 15th February, with changes to take effect from Monday 25th February.

It is vital we received notice of any changes as meals are ordered and costs the school valuable funds. If a child is on packed lunch, they should not be helping themselves to school dinners.

If your child has forgotten their packed lunch, please call the school office to let us know if they will need a school dinner for the day—which if applicable would be chargeable and payable through the ParentPay website.

Our Brilliant Brecknock Choir attended the Young Voices 2019 event last


Tuesday at the O2 Arena in Greenwich.
