Year 5 – Friday 20th September at 2.45pm (in Year five class)


Coffee with the Headteacher

The spray will be offered to Reception to year 6 children only.




Children's health issues can change over time. Please can you make sure that if there have been any changes to your child in terms of medical conditions you keep the school up-to-date. This is particularly the case for
