Draw a map of your neighbourhood or somewhere you know well. Many artists chose to show the view of the fire raging from across the River Thames. What are the similarities and differences?</p>

Write your own diary entry describing the events of the night when the fire started. Imagine you are the penguin, sending a postcard to the boy. Do you know any delicious cake recipes? Make a recipe card or two for the beast, so he can try some delicious new treats.</p>
