### Science: Earth and Space

The emphasis this term is on creating a piece of home learning that shows your interest, engaging research and creativity!

Aim to complete two projects per half term, we look forward to seeing your creations.

	<p>Create a 3D model that represents our Solar System.</p> <p>Think about how your model could differ from those simply representing the major planets! There are other features to our solar system that are of interest! You can use materials of your choice.</p>	<p>Create a 3D model of a prominent Ancient Greek building, such as the Parthenon, and create a fact sheet to explain its purpose, features and history.</p>	<p>Ancient Greeks and Romans felt strongly about their Gods. Can you design your own God? What would their power be? What would they wear? Can you think of a name and symbol for your God?</p>
	<p>Research an astronaut or cosmonaut of your choice and write about their life and achievements in a biography, poem or write about one of their major achievements in a diary entry form.</p>	<p>Life in Sparta was very different to life in Athens. Where would you rather live? Write a diary entry from the point of view of a Spartan or Athenian person. Will you be a young boy or girl? Is life fair?</p>	<p>The Romans invented Roman Numerals as their number system. Can you write your times tables using Roman Numerals? Will you be able to memorise them?</p>
	<p>Create a multiple choice quiz on the important milestones in space exploration that can be used to test your fellow classmates!</p>	<p>Research a Roman invention that is still used today, for example roads, the sewage system and heating. Use Microsoft Word to create a fact page about the invention.</p>	<p>Ancient Greece is very different to life in Greece today. But, what has stayed the same? Research the differences and similarities between Ancient and Modern Greece. Create a PowerPoint to show your findings.</p>
	<p>The mission to Mars goes wrong, you report the presence of an alien life form!</p> <p>Write a short story about humans making contact with alien life, you can use whatever genre you like, even mix two genres! Think about the reader and what would make a memorable twist!</p>	<p>Create a playscript for an exciting part of a Greek myth that we have read (Adventures of Odysseus) or one that you are interested in.</p> <p>What could the characters do? Include stage directions in brackets like this [ ... ]</p>	<p>Write a book review about The Adventures of Odysseus. What did you like/dislike? Why? Would you recommend it?</p>
