EYFS Home Learning

Week 1: dinosaurs



Understanding The World

Communication and Language

Use the playdough to build a dinosaur. What does it look like? Describe the dinosaur to your grown up.

Key vocabulary: huge, scary, spikey, tail



Literacy

Draw a picture or write a sentence about the dinosaur. What is your dinosaur's name? What colour is it? Where does it live? Is it scary or friendly? Is it large, long or scaly?

Phonics: use the playdough to make the sound 'd'. Can you think of some more words that start with 'd'? Which other sounds can you make with the playdough?

Other Art & Design ideas

Can you make a dinosaur out of recycled rubbish? What dinosaur will you make? A scary T-Rex? Or a Spikey Stegosaurus?



Maths

Measure the flour, salt and water to make the playdough.

Talk about the different amounts you have used.
