Can I send work to my child's teacher?

Sure! Use the email addresses below. They will not be able to respond to multiple emails but one a day is reasonable.

Where should my child complete their work?

Children can complete work in the exercise book which will be given to them on Friday. Spare books will be kept in the Brecknock dining room if you want to pick one up next week (or get another parent to pick one up for you). Work can also be done on paper or their own book.

What if my child does not have access to the internet?

On top of the online work, we will also be handing out work packs to children. Children in school can take them home on Friday. Those already in isolation can collect them from the Brecknock dining room. If you want to come and collect one next week you can. You can also pick them up for parents of other children. If your child has completed all of their work packs and they do not have access to the internet, please email your teacher and they can organise for more work to be printed off.

What if my child is really stuck or they are finding the work too tricky or easy?

How about suggesting they try an activity from a different year group? They can also click on one of the subsections (Reading, Writing or Maths) and have a go at an activity from one of the suggested websites.

When should my child be working?

It might help the children to have a timetable you follow each day (similar to what they would have in school). It will help you too! We have posted a suggested timetable that can be adapted:
