Animals all move in different ways. Move around like an animal and see if the people at home can guess which animal you are pretending to be.

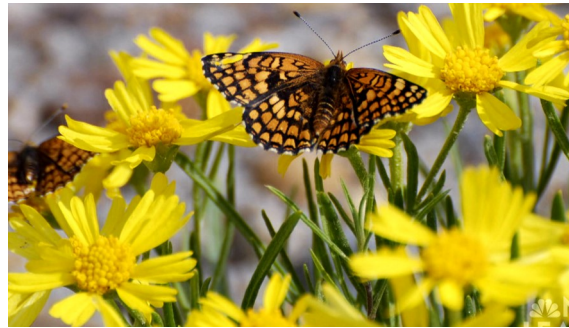
