

Create a silly creature/monster drawing game

What you will need:

Paper—as much as you like!

Felt tips/colouring pencils/crayons.

Someone to draw with—this can be more than one person but up to 4 only.

What you need to do:

- 1) Draw a monster head at the top of your page. Try to use a quarter of the paper. Once you have finished, fold your paper backwards where your head finishes so the other person cannot see what you have drawn. Pass it on to someone else in your group.
- 2) The next person now has to draw the top half of the monster. They can draw things like wings/scales/spikes just as an example, whatever they like. Once they have finished, they have to fold the paper backwards to make sure their drawing cannot be seen and pass the paper onto the next player. Remember, this version can be played between 2 or 4 people. It can be adapted to play with 3 people. You just need to use a third of the paper and not a quarter for each drawing! Using a bit of maths here!
- 3) The next player can now draw the lower half of the body. That could be a tail or some legs, again, be as imaginative as you like. Once completed, fold the paper backwards and pass it on for the final part.
- 4) The last player will complete the drawing of the bottom of the monster. It may have feet or claws or tentacles! Once finished, open the paper up and see what you have all created!
