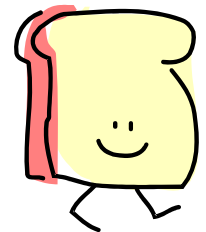


- The underlined words are called imperative verbs; they are direct and tell the audience what to do.
1. Spread butter on one side of each slice of bread.
 2. Slice the cheese.
 3. Place the cheese on one slice of buttered bread.
 4. Put the second slice of bread on top of the cheese.
 5. Cut the sandwich into two or four.
