Steps to success:

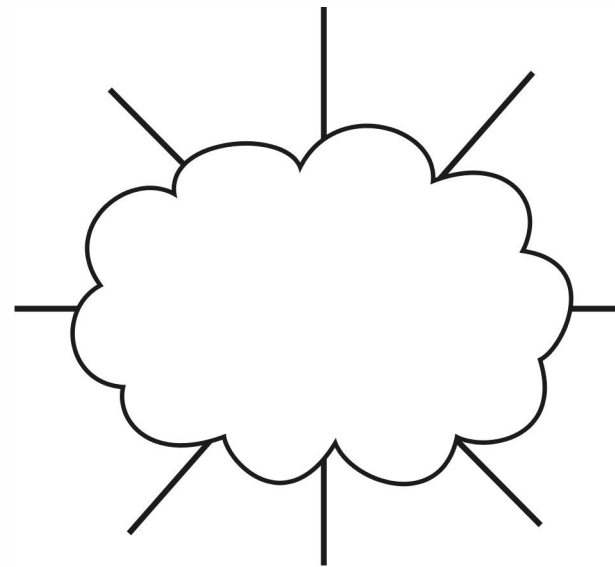
1) Choose a theme for your poem (maybe... chocolate; toys; school; friends; winter; trees...)
