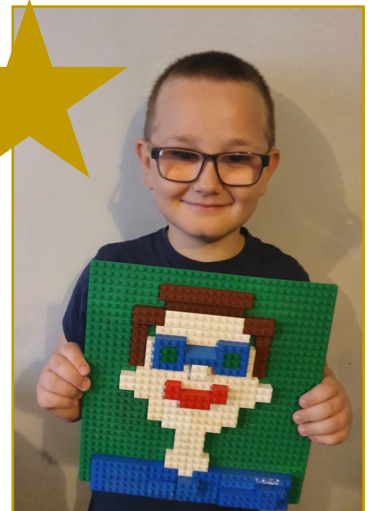
We have already received so many wonderful self-portraits from across the school.
