We have seen such great school work this week, from children in school and from those at home. It is therefore our great pleasure to celebrate some of you as our stars of the week!



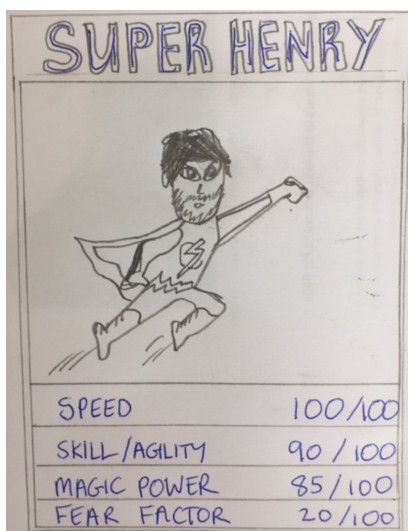
Whole School Task
