Duck has made some towers of bricks. Can you help Duck place the towers in order from shortest to tallest?

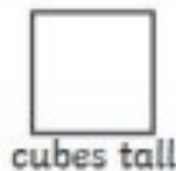


Which tower is the shortest? How many bricks did Duck use for the shortest tower? ____
