

Writing Activities for 3rd July onwards


You wake up one morning to find that animals can speak. Write the conversation you would have between you and your pet. How would you spend the day with your pet or any animal if they could talk?



Where would you like to visit in the world? Choose a country/city to research and then create a brochure/powerpoint or information leaflet advertising it.




Write about the lifecycle of any animal



Design and describe the perfect playground. You should think about including trampolines, slides, hanging vines, ball pits, pick a theme!




Create a book of animals, for each page write information using headings and subheadings and draw a picture of each animal




Imagine that an alien visited earth for a day, what kind of things would you do with them? How would you to speak to them? What would you do, what would you want to show them?

Writing Traditional Stories from a Different Point of View

Read "The True Story of the Three Little Pigs" (by Jon Scieszka) with the children. This tells the "Three Little Pigs" story from the wolf's point of view.

Ask the children to think of a story that they know well, and to write another version from another point of view.


e.g. Write "Cinderella" from the point of view of one of the ugly sisters,

OR Write "The Three Billy Goats Gruff" from the point of view of the troll,


OR Write "Goldilocks and the Three Bears" from the point of view of Goldilocks.
