
UP-TO-DATE

Dropping Off and Picking Up

We kindly ask parents and carers to adhere to the rules when it comes to dropping off your children in the morning and collecting them at the end of the day.

We ask that it is <u>one adult/ person</u> collecting your child, not 3 or 4, because social distancing is then not possible. If you do come with additional people, they will need to remain off the school premises and away from the school gates/doors.

We kindly ask that you do not stop to chat to other parents on the school grounds or block the school entrances. If you find that you do need to have a chat, please move away from the gates, to the other side of the road. Please do not gather in the playground either - please line up and keep a 2metre gap between other parents/carers.


Please be reminded that you can not park outside the black gates on York Way, you risk getting a ticket from traffic wardens. Camden Council are trying to encourage as many people as possible to walk to school with their children. Whilst we know that some of you lie further afield, you must not park up and block the road or the school gates.

Please be reminded that parents must not walk through the playground to visit the school office, you will need to walk around the school and buzz for the office on the Cliff Villa entrance.

No parents are allowed in the school office unless you have a pre-booked meeting.

School Photos

As you know this school year has brought a lot of changes, due to COVID restrictions and the need to be socially distant. We are trying to continue with as many normal yearly activities as possible, even though some maybe virtual. One we will still have are school photos.
