



Children Returning to Brecknock School



School will re-open for **all** children on:

Thursday 3rd September 2020.

To keep everyone safe we have had to make a few changes which include the time children arrive and leave everyday, who can bring them to school and what resources they will need. We have also made some temporary changes to our timetable to keep children in smaller groups. Please read this leaflet carefully to ensure you know the specific arrangements for your child.

Hygiene and infection control:

- ◆ All children will wash their hands on arrival in the classrooms.
- ◆ Hand wash and hand sanitizers are provided
- ◆ If your child has a packed lunch they will be asked to wipe the bag down on arrival into the classroom
- ◆ Children will move around the school in the middle of the corridors not touching walls, bannisters or handles if possible (external doors and windows will be open to increase ventilation)
- ◆ Children will wash their hands every time they return to the classroom.

Bubble Management:

- ◆ Keeping children in class/year group bubbles is the key to our plan. When they are in their bubble safely within their designated teaching room there will be no need to keep strict social distancing because the bubble will operate like a family group.
- ◆ We are of course reliant on you following the same safe social distancing rules in line with the latest government guidance.
- ◆ They will of course have break times and lunchtimes outside but this will only be in their year group bubble, they will not mix or come into contact with any other bubble.

Additional Information:

- ◆ No parents/collecting adult should enter the school or the school office at any time without an appointment (except for EYFS settling).
- ◆ Parents should remain at 2m distances where possible.
- ◆ As soon as you have collected your child you need to leave the area – there must be no congregating.
- ◆ If a parent wishes to talk to a teacher / member of school staff they should remain at a safe distance until after dismissal of all children.

Arrival

Year Reception : Monday—Friday **9am** at **York Road Entrance next to the car park** (line up either side of the gate). You will be greeted by senior leaders and children will come into the playground and line up in their class line where their teachers will be waiting.

Butterflies (Nursery) : Monday—Friday **9am** at **Cliff Villas Entrance** - Bring your children in the new Nursery gate to the right as you come in the main entrance. You will be greeted by Rachel our Early Years Leader, children will be directed into the Nursery classroom, parents will be allowed access for settling.

Caterpillars (2YO): Monday—Friday **9am** at **Cliff Villas Entrance** (bring your children in the new Caterpillars gate to the right as you come in the main entrance). You will be greeted by Natalie Room Leader, parents will be allowed in for settling.

What if someone has symptoms of COVID 19?

1. If your child or someone in your household, has symptoms (a temperature or a new continuous cough, or loss of/change to their sense of taste or smell) please let us know in school and keep your child and the rest of your household at home.



2. If a child or member of staff gets these symptoms in school, they will be sent home with advice about what to do.
3. Anyone with symptoms needs to self isolate along with all of their household and get tested as soon as possible. Find out how to get a test and how long to isolate at [nhs.uk/coronavirus](https://www.nhs.uk/coronavirus).
4. If the test is negative, and the person no longer has symptoms, the child and their household can leave self-isolation and return to school.
5. If a child or member of staff tests positive, then the rest of their class group will be sent home to self-isolate for 14 days. The households of these other children do not need to isolate, unless their child also develops symptoms.
