

VOCABULARY

Christian: someone who believes in God.

God: Christian's believe he is the creator of the world.

Jesus: the son of God.

Bible: Christian Holy Book.

Old Testament: the part of the Bible before Jesus was born.

The New Testament: the part of the Bible with stories based on after Jesus was born.

Creation: the story from the Bible that explains how the world was made by God.

Genesis: the part of the Bible that explains the story of creation.

Lord: see God.

Mary: mother of God the son (Jesus).

Joseph: Mary's husband

Christmas: when Jesus was born.

Shepherds: they look after animals and visited Jesus when he was born.

The wise men/Maji: study the stars.

Herod: the King when Jesus was born.

Gold, frankincense and myrrh: the special gifts the wise men brought to Jesus.

Gabriel: the angel who visited Mary.

MAIN IDEA


Christian's believe in the story of creation and that Jesus was the son of God.

WHAT COMES NEXT

Year 2 - What Christian's believe about forgiveness.



WHAT YOU SHOULD ALREADY KNOW

Children should know that Christianity is one of the main world religions and that they believe in God.

To know Christmas is an important celebration for Christians.

KEY LEARNING

To know that Christians believe that God created the world and everything in it in 7 days and this story came from the Old Testament in the Bible (Genesis).

To know that Christians believe Jesus is the son of God and that his mother is Mary.

To know the story of Jesus' birth from the Angel Gabriel appearing to Mary to Jesus being born in Bethlehem.

To recognise the order of the key events in the Christmas story in the Biblical narrative.

To understand that Advent is an important time for Christians when they prepare to celebrate the birth of Jesus.

VOCABULARY

God: the creator of the world.

Old Testament: the part of the Bible before Jesus was born.

Torah: the law of God as revealed to Moses—the first 5 books of the Hebrew Bible.

Creation: the story from the Bible that explains how the world was made by God.

Genesis: the part of the Bible that explains the story of creation.

Moses: A Hebrew prophet who led the Israelites out of slavery in Egypt.

Prophet: a person who speaks the word of God.

Hebrew: a member of the people that lived in Israel/Palestine a long time ago.

Star of David: A star made from 2 triangles that is a Jewish symbol.

Covenant: that Jewish people believe they are God's chosen people.

MAIN IDEA



Jewish people believe in one God that created the universe and they believe in the Covenant (Jews are the chosen people)

WHAT YOU SHOULD ALREADY KNOW

Children should already know that some religions believe in one God.

They should be familiar with the story of creation as believed by Christians—that God created the universe from nothing.

KEY LEARNING

To know that Jews believe in one God who created the universe (Genesis story of creation).

To know the basic elements of the story found in Genesis:

- God made the world from nothing.
- God made everything in the world,
- Man is the last to be made.
- Man is given the responsibility to look after the world.

To know the Jewish name for God is Abonai which means 'Lord'

To know the Star of David is a symbol of Judaism and to know it represents the 6 days of creation found in Genesis.

To know that Jewish people live all over the world but Israel is considered special to them and is their promised land.

VOCABULARY

Muslim: People who follow or practice Islam.

Mosque: place where Muslim's worship.

Allah: the one and only God in Islam.

Muhammad: chief prophet of God.

Quran/Koran: the Islamic Holy Book as dictated to Muhammad by God.

Mecca: where Muhammad was born.

Creation: Muslim's believe that Allah created the universe.

MAIN IDEA


Main beliefs of Islam - Allah - the God and Allah created the universe. They believe that Muhammad is the messenger of God.

WHAT CAME BEFORE

That other world religions believe in one God and that he created the universe.

WHAT COMES NEXT

Islam – Where do Muslim's worship? Mosque and importance of prayer (one of pillars of Islam)



WHAT YOU SHOULD ALREADY KNOW

Through study of other world religions children will already know that that some religions believe in one God and that he created the universe.

KEY LEARN-

To know that Muslim's call God 'Allah' which means The - God.

To know that Muslims believe that Allah created all things that exist.

To understand that even though Allah created everything, humans have the responsibility to look after creation.

To know that Muhammad taught Muslims there are 99 names for Allah which describe what He is like.

To know the two main beliefs in Islam are:

- There is one God.
- Muhammad is the messenger of God.
