Addition: It means finding the total. Combining two or more numbers together to see how many in total.

Bridging ten: Another name for Regrouping. When our ones create a new group of ten.

Counting on: When adding, starting with the bigger number and counting on from there.

Non-regrouping: Not having to carry any ones into the tens column.

Regrouping: When ones carry over to make a new group of ten. If I have 12 ones, I can make one group of 10 and have 2 ones left over.

Total: The answer when adding.




Counting On

Steps to Success

- 1) Write the calculation.
- 2) Partition the smaller number.
- 3) Draw a number line with a ruler.
- 4) Put the bigger number on the number line first.
- 5) Jump the tens and put new number underneath.
- 6) Jump the ones.
- 7) The final number you land on is your answer.
