[My Maths - Year 2- 6](#)

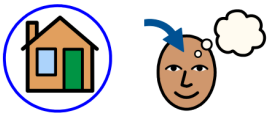


All children from Yr 2 to 6 have been given a login for MyMaths. Questions are randomly generated to provide limitless practice and instant marking provides immediate feedback for children.

The Caribbean region has more than 700 islands.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> People migrated from the Caribbean to find work in the UK between 1948 and 1973. They moved to help fill post-war labour shortages in the UK. It was seen as the "motherland" leader of the empire. The HMT Empire Windrush first anchored in Tilbury Docks Essex on 21st June 1948. The ship had carried over 1,000 passengers on an 8,000 mile journey from the Caribbean to the United Kingdom, crossing the Atlantic Ocean. People who arrived in Britain went to work in the transport and rail services, as well as the National Health Service (NHS). Many people from the Caribbean experienced racism and discrimination in their daily lives and at work.
